DEVELOPMENT REPORT

Infrastructure: Every year the institution upgrades campus facilities and library books. Within a short span of time the Seminary is updated with Academic facilities, Administrative Block, Class rooms, Hostels and Dining hall. In 2015 the new Library hall has been successfully completed. The new Church building of the Seminary is still under construction and hopefully it will be completed by the end of this year by His grace.

Learning Resources: The institution upgrades the Library every year. At present the library consist of Four thousand (4000) books in volumes. In 2015 the library has been upgraded with Three hundred (300) new titles of academic books and some journals. 80% of the Library books are purely academic and at present 45% of the library books and materials are Asian Authored or related to the Asian context. The Institution looks forward to buy more books on Asian Authored or Asian context. The institution is also gearing up to computerize the library at the earliest. We beseech your prayer support for our Library up-gradation.

Students' Life: Besides the campus development and academic learning, different programs and activities are maintained to help the students developed skill in their learning. Students show tremendous improvement in the process of training and are well prepared to join the ministry. The successful placement and effective ministries of the graduated students are the results of our quality education.

Students are given opportunity to open up and share their personal problems and difficulties with the teacher in-charge during the student improvement program. Timely counseling and proper guidance with emphasis on prayer helps the students improve their personal confidence in God.
